Starting next year, each K-8 campus will be using the same math textbooks and program, contributing to a comparable education at each location and an easier transition to LeBlond for high school! The elementary teams collaborated to choose the new program, and the processes that have been created will ensure a smooth experience in the future as more subjects are streamlined. Religion/Theology textbooks will also be the same.



Thanks to a generous grant from the FIRE Foundation, the St. Joseph Catholic Academy will have a Special Education Coordinator during the 2024-2025 school year! The Special Education Coordinator will manage special education at each of the SJCA campuses. The Special Education Coordinator will be responsible for writing SEPs, meeting with parents, and working with the St. Joseph public school district. Additionally, they will consult teachers and guide them on best practices for supporting students, providing accommodations, and will assist them with creating inclusive lesson plans. We are thrilled to have this new resource available within our Academy!



SJCA is hiring elementary, middle, and high school teachers! Our campuses enjoy a faith-filled environment with small class sizes, administrative support, and strong relationships. Our Academy had a 97% teacher retention rate last year, and as an additional benefit, beginning next year, all full-time certified teachers will receive a full tuition scholarship for their children who attend school at any SJCA K-12 campus.
